Criteria:

- Must be licensed in the State of New Hampshire, COTA/L or OTR/L.
- Contribution to the quality of fieldwork education in the state of New Hampshire by directly supervising at least 2 OTA and/or OT students for Level I and/or Level II fieldwork over the previous 12-month period.
- Positive evaluations from students who completed their fieldwork experiences with this clinical educator.
- Contributions to occupational therapy education beyond the fieldwork (i.e., provides in-services, is a guest lecturer at a college, speaks at a community center, serves on committees at local OT/OTA education program, and so on)
